Officer Anthony Joseph DiPonzio joined the Rochester Police Department (RPD) in February of 2008. A year later, while responding as a back up to a call, Anthony was shot in the back of the head and sustained serious life-threatening injuries to his brain. Through many prayers and by the grace of God, Anthony survived and is making remarkable progress with the help of physical therapy. He expects to go back to work at RPD light duty very soon.

Officer DiPonzio made his first visit to the Happiness House New Friends Preschool Program, causing quite a stir among our students! Anthony shared a little about his workday, showed his badge, and answered student questions with a smile.

Less than two weeks later, Officer DiPonzio spoke to a sold-out gathering at the 7th Annual Happiness House Gala Dinner & Auction Event. His keynote address was eloquent and inspiring.

Anthony returned to Happiness House to participate in the National Read Across America day. He read a few stories to our children, and brought some fellow officers along to visit as well!

Anthony's inspirational story and easy laugh has been a source of hope to all of us here at Happiness House. We are pleased to announce that Officer DiPonzio has accepted our invitation to join the Happiness House Foundation board. As a traumatic brain injury survivor, Anthony offers valuable insight and is passionate about the cares and concerns of individuals of all ages with disabilities. We look forward to seeing Anthony here at Happiness House more often!

## MARY WALSH BOATFIELD RECEIVES HONORS

Mary Walsh Boatfield, Happiness House CEO, has been chosen as a recipient of the Athena Geneva Award hosted by the Geneva Area Chamber of Commerce. This award is given annually to women in communities around the world to recognize leaders who demonstrate excellence, creativity, and initiative in their profession. Mary has been in the field of developmental disabilities for over 30 years.

Ms. Boatfield has also been chosen by State Senator Michael F. Nozzolio (R-Fayette) to receive the "Women of Distinction Award". The "Women of Distinction" award is intended for a woman who has made substantive improvements in an organization, demonstrated effective leadership and management, improved the quality of an organization, and helped people develop their leadership abilities. Her progressive leadership philosophy provides a strong foundation for her extensive responsibilities in the areas of operations, finance, development and fundraising. Happiness House serves 1,000 individuals annually, and with 230 employees, is the 16th largest employer in Ontario County. As the agency's CEO, Happiness House's revenue has doubled, to almost a ten million dollar agency in 2009. Projects to enhance service growth and economic development under Mary's direction include: completion of a \$3.5 million dollar building project, opening the agency's first community residence for youth, constructing a new 23,000 square foot preschool and adult program facility in Canandaigua and a 4,500 square foot expansion project in Geneva, and the inauguration of the Happiness House Foundation.

## Focus on Photo Club

The Happiness House TBI (Traumatic Brain Injury) Structured Day Program's Photo Club began in 2008 as a basic photography class. A hit from the start, it has grown from using disposable 35 mm cameras to using digital point-and-shoot and digital SLR cameras to produce their work.

The Photo Club presented their first exhibit at the Wood Library in Canandaigua in October 2008. Presented in memory of Frank McClelland (a member who passed away), "Reflections" was very successful, receiving attention from the local newspaper.

The Photo Club has had many technology upgrades and additions, including new software, printers, and cameras. A second Wednesday class was added in response to growing interest in the club, as well. Shoots on location are scheduled regularly as weather permits. The Photo Club was recently featured in the Happiness House Gala Dinner Program, and is currently working on a Finger Lakes Winery calendar.



## Former student, now an Eagle Scout, gives back to Happiness House

A former student with the New Friends Preschool Program, Robert J. Quinn Jr. recently presented his Eagle Scout Service Project at the Happiness House Canandaigua site. Quinn, age 24, has been a part of Troop #1 of Geneva, a troop dedicated to scouts with special needs, for the past 17 years. He has received services from Happiness House since he was 18 months old. With the help of many in his community, he put over 600 hours of hard work into the "Children's Garden" project over the past year.

Completion of the "Children's Garden" fulfills one of the requirements necessary to obtain the Eagle Scout Rank, the highest attainable in the Boy Scout program of the Boy Scouts of America. Quinn has since been recognized as an Eagle Scout in a special ceremony held by the Boy Scouts of America. He is the first in his troop to hold this special rank.

Robert was also this year's recipient of Happiness House's "Volunteer of the Year" award. This award is presented to an individual who has provided extraordinary service over a significant period of time to Happiness House and to the Finger Lakes community, and is a tribute to Robert, who has helped create a more caring community by volunteering his time and talent.
